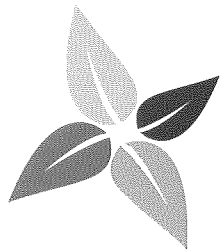

On behalf of the staff, volunteers and food recipients from the Kelowna Community Food Bank, I'd like to offer my heartfelt appreciation to you for being a proud supporter of our first annual Beer Fest.

On a typical day, we help nearly 100 children, women and men in Kelowna with food hampers valued at more than \$6,000.00. Be assured that your generosity is directly helping provide nutritious food to low-income Kelowna families and children. More than 1/3 of the people we serve are children under the age of 15. Nearly another third are low income wage earners, while the remainder of those we assist are on disability, social assistance and fixed incomes.

We are very excited about a number of programs and events that will be taking place in 2008. Our *Plant a Row Grow a Row* program has been very successful, bringing in more than 38,000 pounds of fresh produce to the Kelowna Community Food Bank since its inception in 2004. We are looking forward to kicking off the initiative again this spring.

Our Nutrition Improvement Programs continue to assist pregnant women, mothers with toddlers under one year of age, seniors, and people with health issues by providing recipients with extra nutrition such as milk, eggs, formula, fresh fruits and vegetables. Our *Kids Snack Pack* program gives children between the ages of one to six a one-week supply of ready-to-eat, nutritious (age appropriate) snacks, as well as monthly educational newsletters.
